- Students create a short film about their own experiences in Italy.

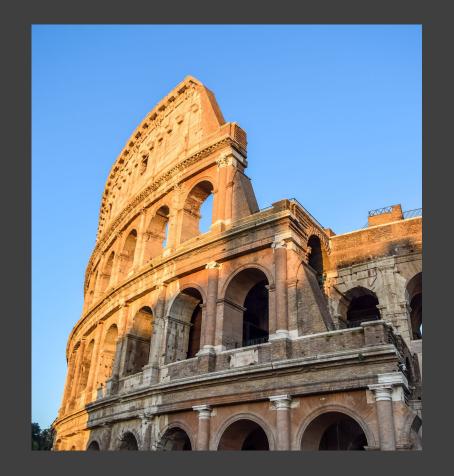
