2 Blocks - 12 weeks/12 credits

3 Blocks - 18 weeks/18 credits

# In addition to 1 block abroad, do you plan to also take courses during the opposite Session (A or B)?

## Why is this total amount different?

The 1 block program only covers 6 credit hours of tuition and takes place during either Session A or B. If you plan to also take ASU i-courses or ground courses during the session that you are not abroad, then you will pay for an additional **1 credit hour**. ASU stops charging resident students for additional tuition once they reach 7 credit hours.

# 1 Block Option Example

Abby is an Elementary Education major interested in going on the Santiago Open Campus program for 1 block. Based on course scheduling, she has decided to go abroad for Block 1 (earning 6 credits) and return to ASU in time for Session B. She plans to take two courses (6 credits) during Session B. In total, she will be enrolled in 12 credit hours for the semester. Here is what she can expect to see billed to her ASU student account:

Item	Amount
Application Fee	\$50
Program Fee	\$4,950
ASU Fees (minimum)	\$66*
International Travel Service Fee	\$64.50
ASU Tuition for Session B	\$765
<b>Total billed to MyASU</b>	<b>\$5,895.50*</b> - <u>not</u> including <b>out of pocket expenses</b>

\*In this example, the student is part of Mary Lou Fulton Teachers College which does not charge a college fee.
