This process is automated for Faculty-Directed and Global Intensive Experience programs. For partnership and exchange program participants: 1. After confirming participation, print a Cost Sheet for your program and term, available on the Study Abroad Office website. 2. Sign your section, and then take it to the Study Abroad Office for a signature from an International Coordinator. 3. Submit the signed cost sheet to Financial Aid and Scholarship Services for financial aid eligibility reassessment.
