



Signature Verification Form

The ASU Global Education Office (GEO) online application process involves electronic signatures. GEO must give you permission to use a digital signature for the remainder of the application process.

Incoming Exchange Students

Your International Coordinator will grant this permission to you after you have uploaded a valid passport to your online application. Once this item has been marked as *Received*, you will be able to digitally sign any documents within your online application.

Please upload a legible scan of the photo/information page of your valid passport that meets the following requirements: - You may upload a PDF or JPEG document. - You must upload a high-quality COLOR document. - The upload must be a flat scanned copy; pictures of passports will not be accepted. - Your passport scan should not be cut off on any sides and must include the page that is opposite of your photo information page. Do not crop your passport scan so that it is only your photo/information page. - If your signature is on a separate page from the photo/information page, please upload both pages. **Note for US passport holders:** If you are a US passport holder, you must upload a copy of your US passport below. All US passport holders will be required to enter the United States with their American passport and will not be issued visa documents. **Within 7-10 business days of uploading, ASU staff will give you access to electronically sign the Statement of Understanding. It will not happen automatically.**
